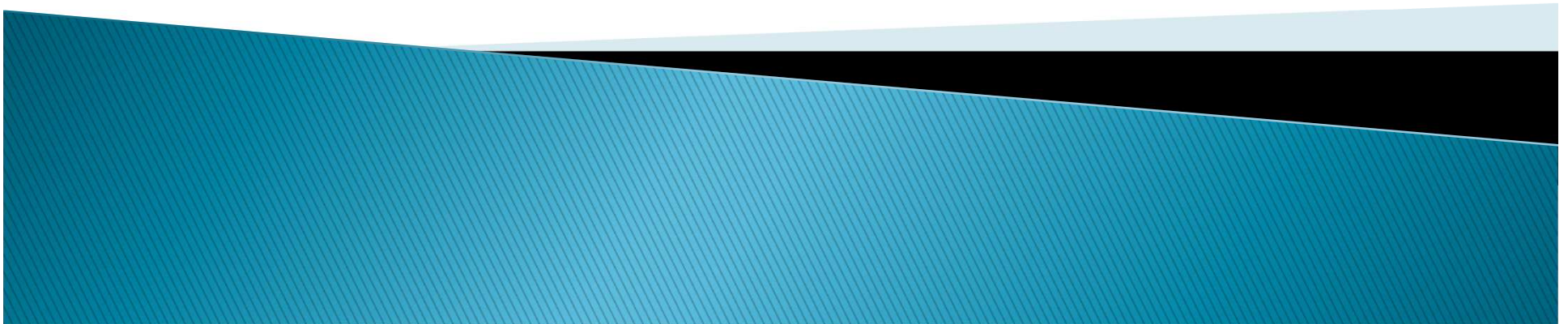

# General Safety and Security

- ▶ Community expectations vs. College/District expectations vs. capacity to deliver services
- ▶ Staffing
  - 24 hour, 7 day a week coverage
  - Police, dispatchers, security, clerical, administration
  - Limitations for Part-Time Staff
    - Restricted number of hours/days that can be worked in a fiscal year
- ▶ Recruitment and Retention
  - Competition



# Physical Security

- ▶ Access Systems
  - Key Control
  - Electronic Entry
- ▶ Building Evacuation Program
- ▶ Camera Systems



# Emergency Preparedness

- ▶ Creating and Updating Emergency Plans
  - Preparedness Assessment Team
- ▶ Training
  - Police and Community
- ▶ Special programs
  - Campus Emergency Response Teams
- ▶ Notification Systems
  - Accuracy and Timeliness



# Threat Assessment

- ▶ Important to have formal protocols in place
  - Develop partnerships
- ▶ Behavioral Intervention Teams
- ▶ Coordination with Disciplinary and Title IX Officers
  - Methods or processes to track response efforts
